Common Wealth Credit Union Award Eligibility

- The applicant is currently in grade twelve or in their first year at a post-secondary institution.
- The applicant must be registered in a post-secondary institution in Canada for full-time studies for the coming school year.
- The applicant must submit a completed application and all required documents on or before the **first business day of August 2008**.
- Either the applicant or his/her immediate family must be a member of Common Wealth Credit Union. Immediate family is defined as a parent, brother, sister or grandparent.

Emil Lychak Award Eligibility

The applicant must have graduated from Lloydminster Comprehensive High School, Holy Rosary High School or the Lloydminster & Area Homeschool Association with a full-time student status.

The applicant for this scholarship must also follow the same criteria as the CWCU Scholarship eligibility listed above.

Selection Criteria

These scholarships are in place to recognize youth and young adults who have shown exceptional commitment to their community, leadership with the highest degree of integrity and unparalleled caring for others within their school and community.

- Academic Achievement
- School and Community Involvement
- Leadership responsibilities that the applicant has had within the school and community
- Personal qualities consistent with good citizenship
